- Train public health, medical and emergency response partners related to health, medical and mortuary response

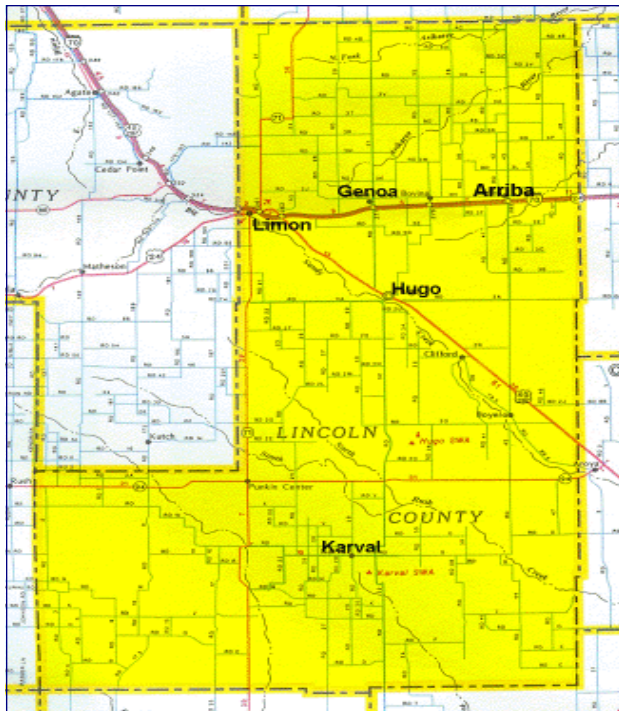


Women's Health
